## WHAT IS A HOUSE LEAGUE?

- All students from grades 6-9 are divided into four 'houses' that are identified by their house name and colour.
- Four House Leaders guide and organize different events and projects within their house as well as participate in intramurals during lunch recess.
- Points are awarded to the houses based on participation, game outcomes and spirit.

## HOW WILL MY HOUSE BE INVOLVED IN THE SCHOOL AND THE COMMUNITY?

- ❖ All House Leagues will be involved in four different activity areas throughout the year.
- ❖ Each activity will rotate every two months to ensure all Houses get the opportunity to experience the different activity areas.

### School Initiative

The House will have a fixed amount of time to create or adopt an initiative program which they feel is worthwhile. This can be to promote spirit in the school and/or the community. The project may continue to run after the house has switched areas of activity and into the next year.

### Jr. House Leagues & Rosh Chodesh

Select students from the Houses, grades 8 & 9, will referee and coach the Junior House Leagues.  
(grades 4-5)

### Creative Art

As a group, the House will decide upon and participate in an art beautification project for the school and/or the community.

### Operation: Tzedaka

The House will decide on a fund-raising project which they can run for a charitable organization.
