## **School Fees:**

### **Tuition**

A deposit of 10% of the annual tuition is required for Nursery-Grade 9 students. Payment of the balance in full or by up to ten monthly post-dated cheques or automatic withdrawals with the final payment dated no later than June 1, 2022.

Parents may apply for an IBP grant through the [Calgary Jewish Federation IBP](#). Proof of IBP application plus a 10% deposit (based on last year's Approved Parent Portion if applicable), along with 10 post-dated cheques or automatic withdrawals dated the first of each month starting with September 1st through to June 1st of the school year. The final payment is to be dated no later than June 1<sup>st</sup> of the school year.

***NOTE: All fee payment arrangements must be in place before a registration can be deemed as complete.***

### **New Family Registration Fee**

- A One Time New Family Registration fee of **\$250.00** will be charged to new registrants

### **Building Capital Fund**

- A Compulsory Building Capital Fund fee of **\$200** will be charged to each family.

### **Bingo**

**There is a Bingo surcharge of \$650.00 per family.**

- Parents who do not choose to pay the Bingo surcharge will be assigned to work Bingos for the school.
- The current Bingo commitment is no more than seven Bingo events per year per family.
- Families with 3 or more children registered at the CJA are exempt from working Bingos and will not be charged the Opt Out Fee (policy #5.28 can be viewed on [www.cja.ab.ca](http://www.cja.ab.ca)).
- Parents will agree to work the assigned Bingos and understand that they will be **fined \$125.00 for each Bingo shift missed. A mandatory fee of \$650.00 will be charged if a family inappropriately misses more than two Bingos in a school year.**
- Parents who opt-out of working at Bingos will pay the \$650.00 (not tax deductible) surcharge noted above by submitting a cheque or completing a credit card authorization form.
- Please note that Bingos are not considered as part of the Parent Participation Program – Volunteer Service Hours.

### **Parent Participation Program**

- Each family is required to complete 7 Service Hours per school year. A \$360 post-dated cheque or credit card authorization must be submitted at time of registration. It will only be charged should a family's 7 Service Hours not be completed.

## **Payment Options of Total Owning**

Parents may choose to pay their school fees by credit card, post-dated cheques or by pre-authorized debit.

### **Payments may be:**

- paid in full upon registration
- paid via ten (10) post-dated Cheques Dated 1<sup>st</sup> of each month
- paid via Credit Card Authorization Schedule

Note: In the event that the parents are divorced or separated, the responsibility for meeting financial obligations to the school will be in accordance with Policy #5.47 Students of Divorced or Separated Parents.

## **Additional Costs if Applicable & Financial Information**

- Our Grade 9 curriculum may include an Israel Experience which will increase the Grade 9 cost by an amount that cannot be determined at this time, but may be approximately \$6500.
- Our Grade 8 curriculum may include a trip to Washington, DC which will increase the Grade 8 cost by an amount that cannot be determined at this time, but may be approximately \$2200.
- Our Grade 7 curriculum may include a trip to Salt Spring Island, BC which will increase the Grade 7 cost by an amount that cannot be determined at this time, but may be approximately \$1650.
- Parents will be required to pay any additional cost for any overnight field trips; however, no student will be denied the opportunity to travel if they are not able to pay the full amount of the travel experience.

## **Assessments**

- Should a student be recommended by the G.A.I.N. team for an individual educational assessment, this will be on a cost-share basis with parents when school funds are available. Such assessments are not undertaken without parents' prior consent.

## **Tuition Refund and program changes**

- Where registration is cancelled for a Nursery student who is not ready (toilet trained) for school by school opening, the non-refunded deposit will be applied to tuition should the student be enrolled at the CJA by the start of the following year. All applications for registration are subject to the Registration Policy # 5.37 (policy can be viewed on [www.cja.ab.ca](http://www.cja.ab.ca)).
- Please note if you request a change in your child's PM program (Discovery Days, Kinderarts, Gan Khugim) during the school year, you will be charged for the full month – it will not be prorated.

**All outstanding fees, tuition, fines and volunteer hours must be completed prior to final acceptance for the following school year. Application for registration may be refused at the discretion of the Head of School.**
